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It was during the month of February 2026 that the Holy Spirit gave me this word, and I trust and pray that it will open portals of glory and faith in your life. I was directed to release this by my birthday this week, March 26th. I was also instructed to give this eBook free. Freely I have received—now freely I give. Get ready to have your life changed and your faith soar!

When you see me or read me speaking on grace, understand—this is real. This is not theory, and this is not religion. There is absolutely nothing you can do in the natural or in the spirit that could ever earn the salvation Jesus purchased for us with His own blood.

If you read through the Levitical laws and the things Moses, the priests, and the prophets had to do just to enter the presence of the Lord, it will absolutely blow your mind. Imagine slaying goats, bulls, turtle doves, and calves. Most people can't even stand the sight of blood, let alone be responsible for animals being sacrificed with blood pouring out—yet this was the priest's duty.

This was the requirement to enter in the presence of Jehovah. It wasn't optional, but it was necessary. Without the shedding of blood, there was no remission of sin. The blood sacrifice was not man's idea—it was something God Himself required.

Hebrews 9:13-14

“For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?”

Hebrews 9:12

“...with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.”

Once a year... everything stopped.

This wasn't casual. This wasn't routine. This was life or death.

The high priest would begin by preparing himself, because you cannot walk into the presence of a holy God casually. He had to wash his body—a symbol of purification. He had to lay aside his regular priestly garments and put on simple linen garments—representing humility before God.

No glory. No pride. Just purity and the fear of the Lord.

Before he could even deal with the people, he had to deal with himself. He had to offer a sacrifice for his own sin. Because even the one representing the people... was still flawed.

Think about that.

The mediator needed a mediator.

Two goats were then brought forward: the sacrificial goat and the scapegoat. The sacrificial goat was slain, and its blood was carried into the Holy of Holies. Then the priest laid his hands on the other goat—the scapegoat—confessed the sins of the nation over it, and sent it away into the wilderness.

One goat died for sin, and the other carried sin away.

Then came the moment...

The high priest stepped beyond the veil. He was alone, silent—but carrying blood. No audience. No second chances. If anything was done wrong, he would die in the presence of God.

Tradition says bells were on his garment and a rope tied to his ankle...

Because if he dropped, no one could go in to get him. They would have to pull him out.

He would then sprinkle the blood on the mercy seat, making atonement for the sins of the nation. But hear this—it didn't remove sin; it only covered it.

After all that—the fear, the blood, and the process—it had to be done all over again the next year. Because sin was never fully dealt with.

But this is where it gets good!

Jesus—our Lamb of God, our sacrifice—didn't come with the blood of goats and bulls. He came with His own blood. He didn't go in yearly—He went in once for all. He didn't come out worried... He sat down.

Hebrews 1:3

"...when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high."

Hebrews 10:12

"But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God."

Now all of that leads me to this revelation I have for you.

Here is our key Scripture: Hebrews 8:6. ■

"But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises."

BUT NOW!! Yes—now, in your lifetime, March 2026—because of His grace, His love, and His sacrifice, He has obtained a more excellent ministry.

The word "obtained" here in the Greek language is the word *tygchan*■, and it literally means "to hit the mark," as one throwing a javelin or arrow.

So when we missed the mark, Jesus hit the mark with His sacrifice. He hit the bullseye of God's requirements on His cross. So now He has obtained—He has hit the mark—on a more excellent ministry.

You do understand this is the same Jesus who lives to make intercession for us. Now don't miss this: He is also the Mediator—the go-between—of a better covenant. In other words, He is the mediator of a better covenant, now written in His blood.

Who better to mediate for me than the One who gave His life for me? Who better to mediate for me than the One who knows what it is to be like me?

He had all His skin in the game!

So yes—give me the One to defend me who died for me!

So the BETTER covenant is now written with and in His blood! The better covenant doesn't just rid us of sins for a year—it has rid us of sin for eternity. It is not just wishing and hoping for Heaven; this covenant has assured us of eternity with God!

This is not temporary covering—this is eternal cleansing. This is not religion—this is redemption. This is not a system you strive to keep—this is a promise secured by the blood of Jesus.

Under the old, they waited year after year, hoping it was enough. But under this better covenant, we stand in confidence knowing it is already finished. No more guessing, no more striving, no more wondering if we've done enough. The blood has already spoken.

This covenant doesn't just change your future—it transforms your present. You don't have to live bound, condemned, or carrying yesterday's weight. Because of His blood, you are free now, whole now, and accepted now.

So I don't approach God hoping—I come boldly. I don't come trying to earn—I come knowing it's already been paid. I don't come as a stranger—I come as a son.

This is the power... this is the promise... this is THE GRACE FOR BETTER.

Now to the establishing of better promises, some translations even put it this way: resting on better promises.

The blood of God's Son enabled our promises to REST! No labor, no striving, no fighting. If Jesus is my Savior and I have confessed Him, then all of the promises of the Bible belong to me. I do not have to strive to get them! I don't have to labor to receive them. The grace of His blood brought them to my doorstep. The only thing I must do... is receive.

Now here is the revelation, and I'm done. Do not ever forget this:

You can go into the Old Testament and find the greatest promise you can think of. Whether it's wealth, protection, health, or provision—it does not matter. Find your favorite, your strongest, your most blessed Scripture... and it will still pale in comparison to what we have now under the new covenant written in His blood.

Deuteronomy 8:18

“And you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.”

Exodus 23:25

“So you shall serve the Lord your God, and He will bless your bread and your water. And I will take sickness away from the midst of you.”

Psalms 91:7

“A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand; but it shall not come near you.”

Ecclesiastes 5:19

“As for every man to whom God has given riches and wealth, and given him power to eat of it, to receive his heritage and rejoice in his labor—this is the gift of God.”

These scriptures our favorite and beyond powerful... but still not the highest reality.

The Holy Spirit put it like this to me:

“Son, find the greatest, most blessed promises and proclamations in Scripture that you can... then lay this on top—a better COVENANT, resting on better PROMISES—and it explodes, it multiplies, it becomes MEGA!

There is no way you can compare a 1908 Ford Model T (Old Covenant) to a 2026 Lucid Air (New Covenant).

Now you may like old cars. You may restore them. But I guarantee you—you're not taking that thing across the country!

Why? Limited power, limited range, constant maintenance and an 1908 can only take you so far. That's how the old covenant was. That law could not get us very far.

People love to shout about the blessings in Deuteronomy 28 but have you read the curses if you didn't obey ALL the law? Not some... ALL

Deuteronomy 28:1-2

"Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God... that all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you..."

Deuteronomy 28:15

"But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the voice of the Lord your God... that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you." That system was conditional and that system required perfection

BUT NOW... THE BETTER COVENANT

Give me the better covenant, established on better promises, resting on better promises, chilling on better promises!

The blood of Jesus Christ trumps every blessing and every curse. The blood doesn't just match the Old Covenant, it multiplies it, It takes the blessing and puts it on another level entirely.

Romans 8:32

"He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?"

How are you going to beat that?

Haggai 2:8

"'The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine,' says the Lord of hosts."

Now look at that through the covenant. The silver is His, the gold is, and NOW, YOU are His.

Romans 8:17

“And if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ...”

That means what belongs to Him, you have access to.

No one who lives in your home should have to ask, “Can I get something out of the fridge?” My kids knew—if you’re hungry, go get what you need! Now, they also knew not to grab dessert for breakfast and lunch, but whatever else was in there—you had access to it.

Why? Because you are my child.

And if we, being natural, know how to take care of our children, how much more does our Heavenly Father know how to take care of His? He’s not withholding, He’s inviting. He’s not restricting, He’s providing.

I hear the Lord saying to someone right now:

“Go in there and eat! You’ve been hungry long enough!”

Stop standing outside what already belongs to you. Stop asking permission for what has already been provided through the blood. Heaven’s supply is not limited, and the door is not closed.

Heaven’s fridge is full... and you have access.

So come boldly, receive freely, and dine fully because you are not a stranger, you are a son.

So in closing...

Whenever you are reading the promises of God and claiming them for your life, know this—both in the front and the back of your mind: You are living under a better covenant, resting on better promises

You are living with the blood of Jesus Christ over your life and that makes every promise accessible to you.

Not by striving...

Not by laboring...

But by grace

DECLARATION

“I am not under the old! I am established in the better. I don’t strive, I rest. I don’t chase, I receive. Because of the blood of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, every promise of God is mine. I have GRACE FOR THE BETTER!”
